L'interaction, les challenges en équipes, les jeux de rôles de formation font parties des stratégies d'enseignement plébiscitées par le management.

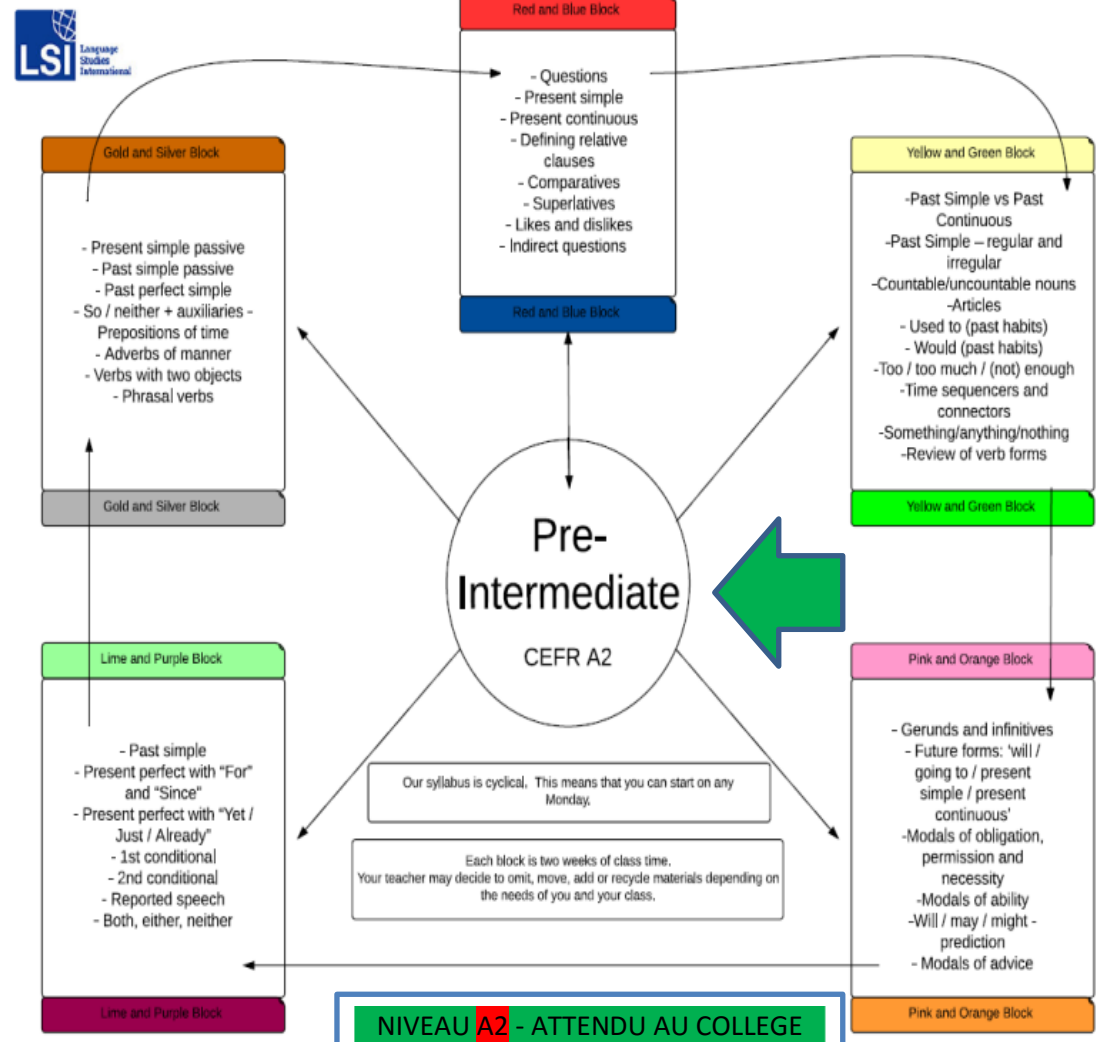
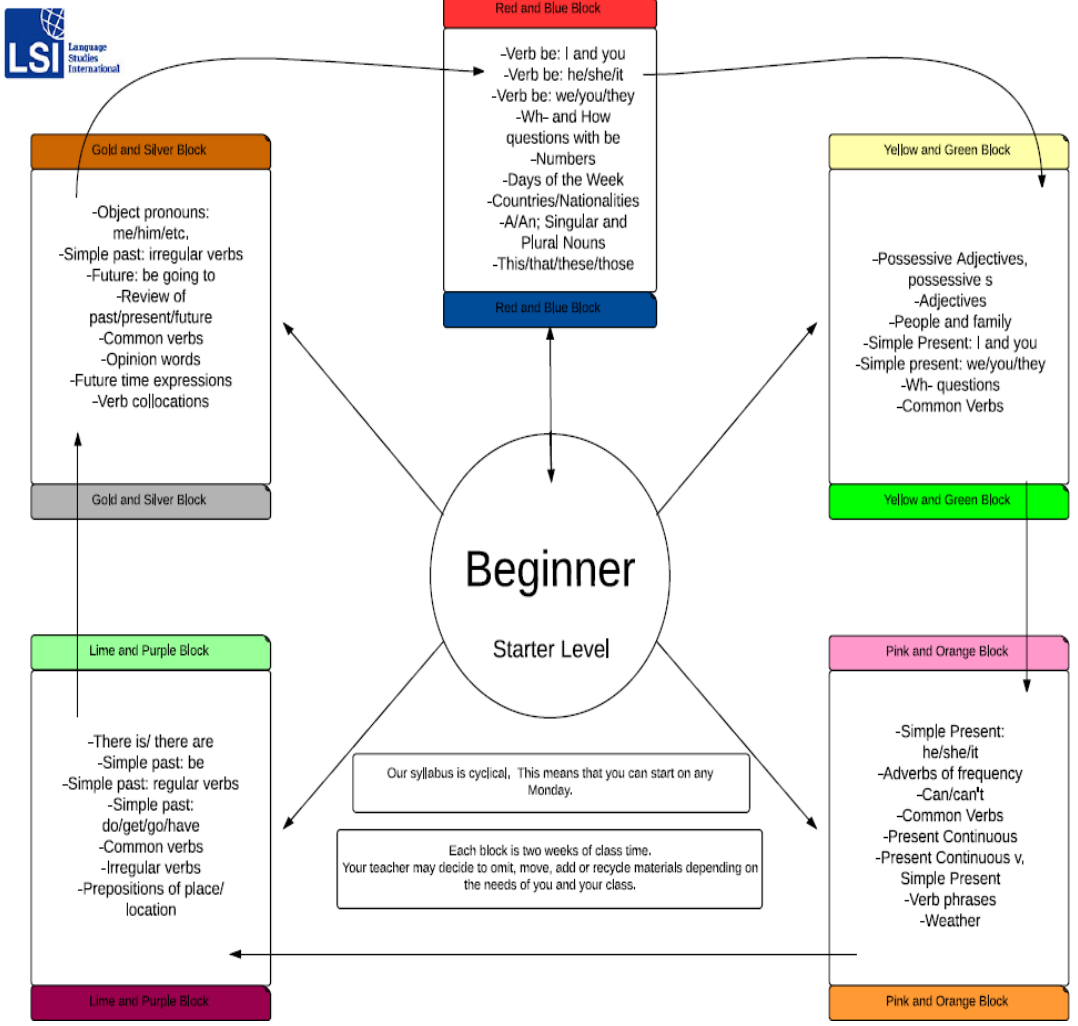
