

OUR LITTLE HEN HOUSE

Behind our school there are 21 hens; 12 were adopted on «adopte1poule.fr» and 9 new hens were given by pupils' parents.

The hen house

The hens lay between 8 and 10 eggs everyday. The eggs are bought by the school staff (2€ for 6 eggs). The hens eat the leftovers from the cafeteria (rice, pasta and vegetables but not meat and not eggs). They also eat grains on Wednesday and at the week-end.

The first hens arrived in March 2020.

The pupils from 3e Prépa-métiers and the ULIS take care of them. They collect leaves from the playground and use them as a litter for the hens on which they can sleep and do their faeces.

The problem is that some pupils throw garbage (papers, masks, packaging, tissues...) on the ground. It's really disgusting and disrespectful ! Indeed, the hens can choke on the wastes and die.

SO PLEASE , PUT YOUR GARBAGE IN THE BINS !

The faeces then become compost which is used as fertilizer for the kitchen garden.
