### Localization




Reunion is a volcanic island in the western Indian Ocean, east of Africa, in the southern hemisphere. It is both a French overseas department and region (DROM).

With a surface area of 2,512 km2, Reunion is located in the Mascareignes archipelago, 172 km west-south-west of Mauritius and 679 km east-south-east of Madagascar.








Flag of Reunion island

## Geography Relief

### Reunion is a volcanic island.

The highest point is the Piton des Neiges at an altitude of 3,070 meters.

Piton de la Fournaise (2,632 meters), located in the south-east of the island, is one of the most active volcanoes in the world.

According to the latest census, the population at 1 January 2020 was 860 000 mainly concentrated on the coasts where the main towns are located, including Saint-Denis, the capital.





The local demography is characterised by the youth of the population and their varied origins, including european, west African, east African, madagascan, indian, vietnamese, mahoran, malayan and chinese. This diversity influences Réunion's culture, which is characterised in particular by its language, Reunionese Creole, its food and its music (sega, maloya, etc)





# Reunion has 24 municipalities organised into 5 conurbation communities. From the point of view of the European Union,

Réunion is an outermost region.




# **Environment and cultural**heritage

Reunion has a varied fauna and flora, although locally threatened by introduced species that have become invasive. Unlike French Guiana, there are no large wild mammals (such as the jaguar or other wild animals).

However, there are many endemic species.

# With the creation of the Parc National de La Reunion, the island was named a UNESCO World Heritage Site for its "Pitons, cirques and remparts" on 2 August 2010.










### Our middle school


