

UNDERSTAND A RECIPE

READ THE RECIPE / MAKE A CARROT CAKE

Prepares les ingrédients, suis la recette du gâteau à la carotte et régale-toi !

Ingredients : 175 g carrots
100 g sugar
100 g of self-raising flour (farine avec poudre levante)
75 ml oil
2 eggs
1 tsp (5 ml) ground cinnamon (cannelle en poudre)
½ tsp (2.5 ml) ground nutmeg (noix de muscade en poudre)
50 g desiccated coconut (noix de coco râpée)
50 g raisins (raisins secs)

Recipe :

- 1- Grease (beurre) a square cake tin (moule carré)
- 2- Finely grate (râpe) the carrots
- 3- Whisk (bats au fouet) the eggs and sugar together until thick and creamy
- 4- Whisk in (incorpore) the oil slowly, then add (ajoute) the remaining ingredients and mix together to combine evenly
- 5- Finally put the mixture in the prepared cake tin and bake in the oven (four) for 20-25 minutes at 190°C until firm to the touch and golden brown
